

As a result of the coronavirus pandemic, we have had to make some changes for group visits to Rosslyn Chapel.

Timed visits

Numbers will be restricted throughout the day to help with physical distancing and managing our capacity. It is important that visits are now booked in advance into one of our 90-minute timeslots –

Monday to Saturday

Early morning 9.00am to 10.30am*

Mid morning 10.40am to 12.10pm*

Lunchtime 12.20pm to 1.50pm

Early afternoon 2.00pm to 3.30pm

Late afternoon 3.40pm to 5.10pm*

Sunday

Early afternoon 12noon to 1.30pm

Mid afternoon 1.40pm to 3.10pm

Late afternoon 3.20pm to 4.50pm*

Please note that visits to the visitor centre, including gift shop and coffee shop, can be made after your 90-minute timeslot. Entry before your timeslot starts will not generally be possible.

Informative visits

Throughout the day, in certain timeslots (marked * above), our Guides will give a short talk in English, lasting around 10 minutes, about the history of the Chapel and its main features,. We also have free information leaflets, with maps of the main carvings, in English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Dutch, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Slovak, Swedish, Japanese and Mandarin. We regret that, at present, we do not have the opportunity for an external guide to speak to a group inside the Chapel, unless the whole timeslot is booked by the group. This includes talks in different languages or on different themes, such as Masonic talks.

Safe visits

Like other visitors, groups must use hand sanitisers on arrival at the visitor centre and are encouraged to keep a safe distance from others. Unless exempt, face masks or coverings should be worn by group members in the visitor centre and inside the Chapel.

Great value visits

Admission prices are -

£9.50 adult

£7.50 concession (visitors who are aged over 60, unemployed,

students or in Armed Forces)

Free children in family group; recognised carers

Pre-booked tickets are needed for each visitor.

Visits, normally covered by voucher, and invoiced, can still be booked on our website. If a Guide is accompanying the visitors, they should still book a place using the option of 'passholder' (free of charge).



All year visits

Rosslyn Chapel is open every day except 24 and 25 December and 1 January.

Terms and conditions for visits

- 1. Proof of purchase should be shown on arrival, either by printed out ticket or on screen.
- 2. Tickets are valid for specified timeslots only and cannot be exchanged for another
- 3. Please note the timing of your visit. You will not be able to start your visit before this time and staff will ask you to leave at the end.
- 4. Proof of concession should be presented on arrival
- 5. Changes to numbers or cancellations should be notified within 48 hours of the visit or the Trust reserves the right to charge for the visit as booked. Once numbers are confirmed and payment has been taken by credit/debit card, no refund can be given for any individuals not attending on the day of the visit.
